Introduction

Allergic rhinitis (AR) is an immunoglobulin E (IgE)-mediated inflammatory disease affecting the upper airways.¹


AR is associated with conditions like nasal congestion, chronic rhinosinusitis, and nasal polyps.^{1,2}



2. Chronic rhinosinusitis


Chronic inflammation of the sinus for >12 weeks⁵

Laryngitis⁵






Orbital cellulitis⁵
